Horizon 2020 and the Circular Economy

"Waste" focus areas 2014-2015: € 190 M



"Industry 2020 in the Circular Economy" **2016-2017**: **€ 650 M**



"Connecting economic and environmental gains – the Circular Economy"
2018-2020: € 940 M

- ✓ 2014: Moving towards a circular economy through industrial symbiosis
 - > BAMB, FISSAC
- ✓ 2014: Recycling of raw materials from products and building
 - > HISER
- ✓ 2016-2017: Systemic: largescale demonstration projects
 - > ECOBULK, PAPERCHAIN
 - > CINDERELA, HOUSEFUL
- ✓ 2018: methods to remove hazardous substances and contaminants from secondary raw materials
 - CREATOR, NONTOX, REMADYL

Horizon 2020: relevant open calls

- Climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials (SC5) (Types of Action: 1 IA, 1 CSA – Budget: 44 M€)
- Cross-cutting activities: Call Competitive, Low Carbon and Circular Industries (Types of Action: 2 IAs, 1 CSA – Budget: 58 M€)



Nanotechnologies, Advanced Materials, Biotechnology, and Advanced Manufacturing and Processing (NMBP) (Types of Action: ERA-NET, 1 RIA, 3 IAs - Budget: 118.5 M€)
